

For instance, using clean energy sources such as hydrogen fuel cells and enhancing productivity to remain competitive, especially considering the expected rise in labour and material costs. Adopting technology to gradually increase productivity is essential. Ultimately, it is necessary to make our foundry industry clean and productive. That is the key to our foundry production."
